DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of basic white thick card stock to 5.5" x 5.75". Score it at 4.25"
2. Cut two pieces of designer series paper (DSP) – Use dimensions listed above.
3. Open the card and place glue or Stampin seal all over the short end of the card flap. Place the largest piece of DSP onto the flap, making sure the design you want to show up on the inside of the card is facing down.
4. Close the card and take the smaller piece of DSP and adhere it to front of the card – butting it up against the white flap of the card base. Be sure you have the side of the DSP that you want to show on the front facing up.
5. Using your paper trimmer or scissors, trim off the excess DSP to clean up the edges of the card so that it measures 4 ¼ x 5 ½ when closed.
6. Using Memento Tuxedo black ink, stamp the birthday candles image all along the left side of the card where white part of the card base is showing. Be sure to use some masking paper or tape to cover up your DSP when you stamp so that you don't accidentally stamp any part of the candle image onto your DSP
7. Take out a piece of scrap basic white cardstock and stamp out the birthday cake and color it, then fussy cut it out.
8. Cut a piece of basic white cardstock to ¾" x 3.25"
9. Flag the end of the strip using the banner Pick a Punch (or a scissors), then stamp the sentiment on the strip using Tuxedo black memento ink.
10. Cut a piece of poppy parade cardstock to ¾" x 3.25" and flag the end just as you did for the white strip in step #9. Cut the red strip in half and glue each red piece to the ends of the white strip so that you have a little bit of red peeking out on each end of the white strip.
11. Add Dimensionals to the back of the birthday cake and the sentiment strip and adhere to the front of your card using the picture above as your guide for placement.
12. To finish off the inside of the card, cut a piece of basic white cardstock to 4" x 5.25"
13. Stamp the "Make a Wish" sentiment and the little birthday fish. Color the fish.
14. Adhere this inside panel to the inside – centering it on the card base.
